If you register with this optional service, 90% of your medication cost is covered, instead of the usual 80%.

You will have access to on call pharmacists 24/7

Express Scripts Canada provides:

free home delivery in Canada

auto refills and renewal reminders

online transfer and refill requests

note; Express Scripts will not fill prescriptions that contain narcotics

Why?

To help you save money on prescriptions

Convenience of free home delivery for maintenance medications

No change in premiums

Use is optional

How do you save?

You pay 10% of the cost, instead of the usual 20% Lower dispensing fees ESC fills 90 day supplies where appropriate, so you pay for only 1 dispensing fee Substitute lower cost alternatives if you and your doctor approve

How will it be launched?

You will receive an email containing information in mid-November Information will explain how to sign up and how to use the network Signing up for Express Scripts Canada is easy and you do not need to be a Costco member Follow up notification/reminder will be sent in early January
